Footnotes

STRONG HOLD was void of early speed while near the inside, gained momentum through the turn while in the three or four path, came into the lane from the five path while quickly gaining on the leaders then ran down the final leader inside the sixteenth pole. SKIPPING THE SCORE chased the pace from the two path into the turn, took over when pacesetter tired, opened a clear lead into the lane then was caught late. TINGALEO was well placed when not far off the lead, bid three or four wide into the lane and gained the show spot while not a threat to the top two. DEVIL'S HAMMOCK was near the rail into the lane, bid from an open rail inside the eighth pole then hung late. BRENTSVILLE ROAD bid three wide through the turn, got closest to the pacesetter into the lane and weakened during the stretch run. ROCKY BEAR was off to a long lead into the turn then gave way when challenged. FELTON ROAD was in the two or three path through the turn and never factored. FANCY TRAIN was along the rail through the turn and was finished entering the lane from the rail. CATER TO GHAZI trailed into the backstretch, broke down, fell and was subsequently humanely destroyed.
