**Footnotes**

LONE STAR COWBOY stumbled at the start, raced in the three or four path through the turn and into the lane, caught the leader just inside the eighth pole and drew away late. BOONE'S ROAD pressed the pace two wide into the turn, gained the lead entering the lane then was no match for the winner inside the sixteenth pole while second best. ELLENBERGER PARK was near the rail through the turn, raced in the two path through the stretch and was up for the show spot. T BONE TYLER chased the pace along the inside into the turn, was shuffled back as others bid wide then lacked a closing response. STRAIGHT SCOOTER chased the pace from the three or four path into the lane then weakened. FINDING TIME was in the four path near the quarter pole, fanned into the six path for the drive and never seriously threatened. RAPID WARRIOR set the pace into the turn then gave way when challenged. SIAGON TRAFFIC COP was outrun from the three path. CALL ME TONIGHT was outrun throughout while off the inside. MUDD TRACKER was never involved while in the three path through the turn. FERDIE'S GUY trailed into the lane and was eased to the wire.
