Footnotes

SIR WALTER'S ORO chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then drove past the leader in the stretch and held sway in the final stages. CINCO ESTRELLA was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the far turn and was gaining late in the stretch run. KID GALAHAD was far back early, while on the inside into the far turn then made a bid in the stretch with a mild gain late. GUNNER was back early, while on the inside into the far turn then made a bid in the stretch from the rail but flattened out late. MAN FROM MARS was well placed early, while on the inside into the far turn with no late gain in the stretch drive. BOY'S BROTHER BOB set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch. CLIFF'S BEST BET was never far back early, angled into the three path in the far turn and weakened late. BLUE RYDER RED was never a threat. SEAPOPS showed little. OUR DEVIL'S HALO stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faded late. BOOT SCOOTIN BABY was through after a half. OLD SMOOTHIE was done early.
