TRICK O MAN set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn then drew clear in the stretch and held in the final stages. SWEEP THE CODE tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. ROLL N SHINE was back early, swung into the six path in the turn and was gaining late in the stretch run. JUSTANOTHERJOE was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the turn then made a bid in the stretch but weakened late. NO CEASEFIRE angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. RUMORS EVERYWHERE angled into the four path in the turn and steadily faded. NO ORIDNARY SUNDAY was through after a half. WATWOE had early speed then folded up. GREAT SKY DANCER showed little. STAMP IT IAN had brief speed then retreated.
