FLAIR FOR FUN chased the pace early, moved past three wide down the backstretch, cleared on the turn then repelled several rivals through the final sixteenth. SCATTIN' EMMA steadied near the seven sixteenths pole when moving with the winner, chased the leader through the turn, bid near the eighth pole and could not get past. CHAFFED LIPS chased the pace along the inside into the lane, bid from the rail near the eighth pole and did not have enough. NORMANDY QUEEN raced four wide through the turn, fanned into mid-track for the drive and was gaining late. MAGICAL PRIZE was along the inside into the lane, came off the rail for the drive, was finishing willingly when lacking room late. LINDA'S LACE lunged at the start, hustled to the lead, chased the pace into the lane then lacked a response. BREAN CAN raced in the three path into the lane and tired. POWER SHOWER raced five wide through the first, chased the pace from the three path then tired.
