SUNDAY PURSUIT settled off the early pace while off the inside, rushed past the pacesetters on the turn and widened through the lane while being ridden out. BUDGET BARGAIN was bumped at the start and void of speed while off the inside, moved widest into the lane and improved position to be clear for the place spot. JAXSON BE GOOD was unhurried early while off the inside, moved into mid-track for the drive and moved up while not a threat. ISTAN'S FURY was shut off at the start then bid with the winner through the turn while in the three path then tired in the lane. MY MAN JACK was in the five path into the lane and never factored. ABSOLUTELY GOOD bid through the turn from the three or four path, was steadied in the lane and was not a threat. HUNTING FOR DIABLO was never a factor while saving ground. FAITH DELIVERED set or vied for the lead into the turn then retreated. EQUIANO was outrun along the inside. SHINEY was checked at the start, hustled to be in mid-pack down the backstretch then was finished entering the far turn. DEACON CRONE broke to the outside, hustled to set or vie for the lead into the turn then retreated. SEARCH THE LOU was outrun from off the inside.
