Footnotes

MS. TURDUCKEN was unhurried early while off the inside, bid four wide through the turn and into the lane, caught the pacesetter inside the eighth pole and drew clear. SUNDAY TEA BREAK settled back through the turn and behind a wall of rivals while in the three path, fanned widest into the lane and finished with good energy to be up for the place spot. JOZI'S SPIRIT settled off the pace while off the inside, moved up four wide through the turn, was moving well when approaching the leader in the lane but had no answer for the fast closing winner and lost the place spot on the final stride. KELSEY DRIVE set the pace along the rail, was clear with an eighth to go then gave way to the others. AWESOME BABY BABY was in the two or three path through the turn while trailing then moved up in the lane while not a serious threat. MISS MAUREEN stalked the pace into the turn then weakened. MYSTIC CRYSTAL bid three wide through the turn and tired. AUTUMN LIGHT chased the pace from the three path, bid in late turn then faded through the lane. GAYLA'S GOLD was finished after traveling a half while along the inside. AURORA DIAMOND was done after a half while in the two path.
