Footnotes

MR. GREEN vied for the lead early while four wide, angled into the four path in the turn then took over command in the stretch and edged clear late under a steady drive. HE WILL SHINE set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and yielded late in the stretch drive. DADDY J U tracked the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and weakened late in the stretch. BROKEN TANGO was back early, angled into the five path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. FLORIDA'S QUIXOTE was never a threat. CAVANAUGH pressed the pace early while three wide, angled into the four path in the turn and faded late. SPEEDY MEDIA was pulled up and walked off.
