Footnotes

SOCIAL ENJOYMENT tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then drew clear in the stretch and lasted at the wire. OFFICIALLY set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then lost the lead in the stretch but came again late and just missed at the wire. CALL ME SIS hopped at the start then chased the pace, angled into the three path in the turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. SAINT PATTIE BABIE stalked the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and faded late in the stretch. DANCES PLEASURE was never a threat. HOPE'S PLEASURE was never a factor. LITTLEMISSCHOOCHOO was done early. SAM'S CAT trailed the field throughout.
