WHEATON'S EXPRESS tracked the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn then made a bid in the stretch from the inside and edged clear late under a steady drive. CROWN THE CHIEF set the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn but yielded late in the stretch while holding place. JET RAIDER was well placed early, angled into the four path in the turn and flattened out in the stretch run. BAHIM steadied through the turn and angled five to six wide into the lane. GREAT KNOWLEDGE stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late. MOUNT RAZMORE angled into the three path in the turn and faded late. L J'S WAY was done early. KING THOU ART checked hard inside the three eighth pole and soon retreated.
