DOWN THE ROOF stalked the pace early then was shuffled back through the turn then came again in the stretch and drove past the leader while clearing the field late. SPOTLIGHTONME vied for the lead early then took over command, angled off the rail into the turn and drew clear in the stretch but yielded late. WESTERNONE pressed the pace early, angled into the five path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch drive. BLONDE BULLET angled off the rail into the turn and moved up in the stretch run. HOPEFUL SWEEPER set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and faded late in the stretch. RED BEADS was through after a half. REAL OBVIOUS hopped at the start and was no threat.
