RUN ARTEST broke awkward from the gate, angled five wide into the turn with a mid-track rally to get up late. STORM CELLAR was well placed early, angled three wide into the turn then waited for room at the eighth pole and angled around rivals then just missed. SPURTABILITY tracked the pace, angled four wide into the turn then led late in the stretch and faltered late. UNBRIDLED ZIP pressed the pace from the inside, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened. HANK THE TANK angled three wide into the turn and moved up. THINK ABOUT YOU set the pace, angled three wide into the turn and gave way. COACH SID chased the pace, angled five wide into the turn and faded. EGGMOGGIN REACH was through after a half. MY DIAMOND RING never menaced. CAUZICAN was never involved.
