Footnotes

STORMING VOW chased the pace from the two path into the turn, took over entering the lane, gained a clear lead with an eighth to go then held. LORD SULTAN chased the pace from the three path into the lane then offered a late gain from mid-track. BALLACOLLA was void of early speed while in the three path, remained in the three or four path into the lane and found his best stride late. BOOM BOOM CHARLIE raced along the inside into the lane, bid leaving the turn and hung in the final eighth. ELMONT was never a factor while racing near the inside. PROPHET MAN raced in the four path throughout and never factored. GREEN BOY was well back throughout while saving ground and never factored. MAKUTUS set the pace along the inside into the lane then faded along the rail through the lane. TUCKER stumbled at the start, raced wide into the first turn, remained well out from the inside and trailed.
