CART DOCTOR dueled early from the inside, angled off the rail into the turn, drew clear in the stretch and held off rival late. WHEATON'S EXPRESS tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn, made a bid late but did not have enough in the final stages while second best. JOLLY JUNIOR broke awkward from the gate while far back early, swung into the six path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. ROCHE RESERVE broke awkward from the gate, chased the pace early while on the inside into the turn with an empty drive in the stretch. DOWN THE TRACK was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn and improved position late, vanned off after the race. YES IT IS raced up close early, angled into the five path in the turn and faded late. TREASURE CHESTER was through after a half. CRAFTY CAPE had early speed then retreated. DELTA GENERAL was bumped at the start and done early.
