Footnotes

CULLEOKA ROSE chased the pace along the rail, bid entering the lane, waited near the eighth pole when rival stepped in, got through outside the sixteenth pole and edged to the front. RUNAWAY SOUL chased the pace two wide through the turn, bid into the lane, gained a narrow advantage near the eighth pole and could not hold off the winner. CRAZY MAISY DAISY was fractious in pre-load, away alertly to gain the lead at once, remained clear into the lane then weakened inside the eighth pole and barely held the show spot. CASTLE PRINCESS was in the two path through the turn and finished evenly. TACTICAL KATIE was never a serious threat while along the inside. MISS SWEET POTATO was in the three path through the turn and never factored. SINGAPORE RAFFLES was outrun along the inside. SPECIAL PRINCESS was outrun while in the two or three path. SPECIAL DIAMOND was outrun while near the inside. O'MASA raced between rivals into the, clipped heels, steadied sharply then trailed thereafter and was vanned off.
