SWEET LITTLE DIXIE was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn then drove past the leaders in the stretch and drew clear late under a steady drive. SPURTABILITY dueled early while between horses, angled into the three path in the turn and faltered in the late stretch. TEE STAIN vied for the lead while three wide, angled off the rail into the turn and led briefly but weakened in the later stages. PL'SHARD KNOT dueled early, angled into the four path in the turn with no late rally. BUCK WARRIOR pressed early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and faded late. EQUINE BEAUTY hopped at the start while no threat. BUBBALOU was never a factor. MENACING PRESTIGE had brief speed then retreated. SWISS SPEED had early speed then folded up.
