Footnotes

BIG BAD BLUE settled off the pace while off the inside, bid three wide near the quarter pole, gained the lead outside the eight pole,cleared and was kept to the task to hold on to the diminishing advantage. SHALE SHAKER was unhurried early while off the inside, bid three or four wide into the lane and was closing in from mid-track. BAR HARBOR set the pace into the lane while near the two path and yielded just outside the eighth pole. GOLD CACHET was along the inside into the lane and lacked a closing response. EXTERIOR was never a serious factor while saving ground. I HAVE NO IDEA chased the pace along the inside into the turn, bid two wide near the quarter pole and leveled out in the lane. SULTRY PLEASURE chased from the three or four path, was asked for more in the turn and tired. SUCCESSFUL AFFAIR steadily lost ground while near the inside. ICANDAZZLE was finished when entering the turn from the four path.
