RESACA stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then took over command and drew clear in the stretch while holding off the rival in the final stages. ANNIE'S ARROW was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. SHEZ ONA CRUSADE lunged at the start and brushed the gate, angled into the three path in the turn then made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late. WON FOR RANDY set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch run. LADY AT ARMS was well placed early, angled into the four path in the turn with no late bid in the stretch. WHAT A DANCER was never a threat. MICAHS A TOMBOY showed little, vanned off. SELLTHEHEIFER was never involved. WALLSTREET SPIDER had brief speed then retreated. MO RAZZLE was always outrun. KALEIGH'S RIDDLE had early speed then folded up.
