Footnotes

IS HE PROUD trailed early while off the inside, bid four or five wide through the turn and into the lane, caught the leader inside the eighth pole and inched to the front. HONOR MATTERS chased the pace from the three path into the turn, moved to the front entering the lane, was joined by the winner near the eighth pole and gave ground grudgingly. RED WINE was along the inside into the lane and slowly gained. EUROSTEEL raced near the inside through the turn, came off the inside to pass tiring rivals then offered a mild bid through the lane. CARDIFF ROAD was in the three path through the turn and moved up while not a threat. TIGER STRIKE was in the three or four path through the turn and never factored. COASTAL ART bid through the turn from the two path and tired. GOLF TRIP was outrun while in the four path through the turn. BLUELIGHTS N SIREN vied for the lead along the inside and faded. ITS MR. CAT TO YOU vied for the lead while two wide and retreated.
