Footnotes

QUEEN OF ARTS set pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn then drew away late in the stretch under a steady drive. MYSTERIOUSLAKELADY was unhurried early, while on the inside into the far turn then moved up in the stretch while no match for the winner. GERI ROAD tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and weakened late in the stretch run. SNICKLEBRITCHES stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and faded late. ELLIDAY trailed the field early, angled off the rail into the far turn and improved position late. SURELY JACKSON chased the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn with no late bid. NEON LIPSTICK was never a factor. BLIZZARDCONDITIONS was done early. WITTY AND WISE showed little. SCOTLAND PLACE was never involved. WITH KID GLOVES was through after a half.
