Footnotes

TOM ARCHDEACON was unhurried early, swung into the six path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch and was up late at the wire. AL BASHA tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then took over command in the stretch but was caught late. FOR MEN ONLY chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. YAROSLAV was settled off the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and steadied briefly then made a bid in the stretch but weakened late. DONTLAFFHESPAIDFOR set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch drive. AL NASR DREAM (IRE) angled into the four path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch. DENIM stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and was empty in the stretch. FINGER TAPPING tracked the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn and faded late. FIRST OF TEN was never involved.
