**Footnotes**

TITANIUM STAR was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the turn then angled to the rail in the stretch and rallied late then edged past the leader and held in the final stages. GREY GOODS tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then made a bid in the stretch while drifting in and did not have enough late. SOLO GLITTERS set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn then drew clear in the stretch but yielded late. QUARTERBACK SACK was back early, angled off the rail into the turn and flattened out late in the stretch run. HANDSOME HANKERS angled into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. LIGHTNING JACK chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late. DERBY CODE was never a threat. ROAD POET broke slowly from the gate and was vanned off. BARELY NOTICED was through after a half. THURBEN had brief speed then retreated. MAD MAN MIKE was done early. FORTYFOUR HUNTER had early speed then folded up.
