SWEET PAPRIKA was bumped to outside into the first turn, angled into the four path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch and was up late in the final stages. BOLD PEAKS set the pace from the onset, angled off the rail into the far turn but was caught in the late stages. CRIMSON DANCER was back early, angled into the four path in the far turn and was gaining late in the stretch. ANNS VISION tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and weakened late. PRINCESS LAURIE chased the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the far turn with no late bid in the stretch. LA ESCONDIDA trailed the field early, swung widest into the lane and moved up in the stretch. EVERYBUDDYSBIZNESS was on the inside into the far turn while no threat. CLEARLY BEST stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn with no late rally. GAMBLER'S COVE was well placed early, angled off the rail into the far turn and never menaced. SPUNKY BOTTOMS was never involved.
