Footnotes

RON'S PERENNIAL set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn, drew off in the stretch under a steady drive. BORCHETTA was bumped at the start, stalked the early pace, angled off the rail into the turn but was no match for the winner in the stretch and held place. PROUD JUSTICE was bumped at the start, angled into the three path in the turn with some gain in the stretch drive. ILIKEWHATIAMDOING was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the turn with a minor gain in the stretch. WIN AGAIN raced up close early, while on the inside into the turn and steadily faded. CHOSEN CHIEF tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn with no late bid in the stretch and was vanned off after the race. AMY'S BUDDHA broke out at the start then was rushed up and eventually spent.
