JACKS ARE LUCKY vied for the lead two or three wide through the turn, put away challengers inside the eighth pole and edged up. SPURTABILITY was along the rail through the turn, angled three wide into the lane, loomed a serious threat near the eighth pole then could not gain thereafter. SAFARI KID was along the rail through the turn and was slowly gaining. BROTHER JAMIE vied for the lead along the inside into the lane then gave way near the sixteenth pole. SIR DAKOTA was three or four wide through the turn and lacked a bid. LOGAN TOWNSHIP was in the two or three path into the lane then gained belatedly. RYAN'S THUNDER was in the two path into the lane and weakened. M'NAUGHTEN was in the four or five path through the turn and was widest through the lane. OUR LUCKY SOX vied for the early lead into the turn then dropped out in mid-turn. ARROSON was outrun while along the rail. MUCH TO DO was through early while in the three path. BARROOMSTOBEDROOMS was outrun from the four path.
