BULLNOSE BRICK was far back early, swung into the six path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch and drove past the leader while clearing the field late. MILES AND MILES was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but weakened late in the drive. TAURUS THE BULL set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch run. JEMARU was well placed early, angled into the five path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch but was empty late. TICONDERO was never a threat. CLASSICAL RHYTHM stalked the pace early, angled into the four path in the far turn and faded late. ASTAIRE was getting out through the backstretch and the far turn. COWBOY CADILLAC was done early. AMANOFHISWORD showed little. DANCING DON had brief speed then retreated.
