CHRISTMAS PUNCH chased the pace from off the inside, bid three wide into the turn to challenge for the lead, cleared into the lane and widened in the final eighth. COWBOY CHRISTMAS pressed the pace two wide into the turn, moved with the winner into the turn, was no match for the top rival in the lane while finishing second best. SICCARDI was four wide into the far turn when never far back, chased the pacesetters into the lane and moved up for the show spot while not a serious threat. GREY MIST chased the pace from the two or three path into the lane and never was a serious threat. GALLANT moved five wide into the lane and moved up while not a factor. CHEROKEE AXE set the pace into the lane then gave way after straightening. RIP AND ROLL tracked the pace along the inside into the lane then was empty. AMBERGRIS CAYE was done after half while near the inside, altered widest in the lane and never managed a rally. SOONER HUMOR was off to an awkward and poor start, raced three and four wide into the turn and never factored.
