FOR REGISTERED INDIANA BRED, THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$50 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$200 to pass the entry box and an additional \$100 to start, with \$45,000 guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 115 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$21,000 in 2006-2007 allowed 3 lbs. Non-winners of \$14,400 twice in 2006-2007 other than maiden or claiming allowed 5 lbs. Of such a race in 2006-2007 allowed 7 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to the winning owner.

NOTE: This stake will be limited to twelve (12) starters with an also eligible list. If more than twelve (12) horses pass the entry box preference will be given to those with the highest 2006-2007 earnings. Entry fees only will be refunded if failure to draw into the race. Two horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single betting interest. All nomination, entry and starting fees revert back to the I.T.D.F. (S)

Footnotes

LIEPERS FORK was without speed while off the rail, moved four wide through the turn when gaining momentum, fanned into mid-track for the drive, lost whip near the eighth pole then finished with the rider using his right hand to continue urging to the wire. PLAY SMART pressed the pace along the inside through the turn, shook others leaving the turn, opened the largest lead inside the eighth pole then was outfinished by the winner. HEZA WILD GUY chased the pace from the three path into the lane, bid outside the eighth pole then did not have enough. ZORAK was void of speed while near the inside, angled four wide off the rail near the three-eighths pole, fanned widest for the drive and finished willingly but too late. NEED MONEY DAD stalked the pacesetters from the four path then weakened in the drive. FATHER JOHN pressed the pace two wide into the lane then faded. LAZ HAS RISEN was never a factor from the three or four path. LOVE THIS TRICK was never a factor while three wide. PIRATE'S BID raced along the inside and lost ground. GO FOR GLITTER was outrun while five wide through the first. MO FASTER under pressure while setting the pace into the turn then retreated.
