FOR REGISTERED INDIANA BRED FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$50 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$200 to pass the entry box and an additional \$100 to start, with \$50,000 guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 115 lbs.; Older, 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$21,000 in 2007-2008 allowed 3 lbs.; non-winners of \$14,400 twice in 2007-2008 other than maiden or claiming allowed 5 lbs.; of such a race in 2007-2008 allowed 7 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to the winning owner. All nomination, entry and starting fees revert back to the I.T.D.F. If this race is taken off the turf, it will be run at 1 mile and 1/16 on the main track. (S)

Footnotes

EASY TEE was under pressure throughout while along the inside, lost the advantage on the turn, hooked the leader straightening for the drive, was as one with that one until the sixteenth pole then inched to the front. PRINCESS COMPOSER stalked the pace three wide into the turn, bid approaching the lane to gain a narrow advantage then could not hold through the drive. LINDA'S LACE bid late in the turn from the three path, moved closest to the top two with an eighth to go then finished best of the rest while not a serious threat. AMATURE'S PRIZE was in the three path entering the lane then moved up. HEART TEE was two or three wide through the turn and was empty in the drive. BREAN CAN chased the pace three wide into the turn then tired. MODEL'S MEMO raced in the three path through the turn, fanned into the eight path for the drive and was never a factor. LADY NEWTON pressed the pace two wide and between rivals into the turn then faded. CRAZY X LOVER steadily faded along the inside. PAYTHEHOOSIER was outrun near the inside.
