Footnotes

SGT MAJOR SCHLOSKEY tracked the two rival duel down the backstretch, bid three wide into the turn, gained a clear advantage entering the lane then drew away through the lane while being kept to the task. G CAT chased the pace from the three path, was roused stoutly near the three-eighths pole when chasing the eventual winner, got closest to that one entering the lane and was no match the final eighth while second best. HEZA WINNER TOO was in the three or four path into the lane, could not keep up with the leaders and finished best of the rest. TOUGH LITTLE NUT was in the three path through the turn and never threatened. JAYDEE was along the inside into the lane and lacked a bid. IMAGE MAKER vied for the lead two wide into the turn then faded. NO CEASEFIRE vied along the inside while maintaining a short advantage then retreated. RAILROAD ROY was outrun near the rail. WAKIWICKEDWARRIOR was done in mid-turn while in the three or four path. PRIVATE PHARES trailed throughout near the inside.
