RED RALLY vied early while three wide, angled into the three path in the turn then took over command and drew away late in the stretch under a steady drive. SODA JERK set the pace early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and faltered late in the stretch run. ITS MR. CAT TO YOU chased the pace early, angled into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch drive. SHAFTEED stalked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late in the stretch. PUBLISH was unhurried early, angled into the four path in the turn and improved position. JUMP 'IEN was never a threat. EXCITABLE BOY pressed the pace early from between horses, angled off the rail in the turn and faded late. IZZY ALI was done early. JACK IN THE PULPIT clipped heels in the backstretch.
