Footnotes

UPON A PRAYER pressed the pacesetter two wide through the turn, was moving to the front when challenged by the runner-up, dueled with that one inside the sixteenth pole and edged up. AWESOME ACCOLADE chased the pace three wide through the turn, bid into the lane, moved to a short lead with an eighth to go then was denied after battling to the wire. KEY POINT vied for the lead along the inside into the turn, cleared in late turn then yielded to the top two through the lane. KING KID was along the inside through the turn, waited near the quarter pole for room, moved free after straightening in the lane then was empty in the drive. FALSELY ALARMED was unhurried through the turn, swung into mid-track for the drive and moved up while not a threat. BLUEGALE was off a step slow at the start, raced in the two path through the turn, shifted to the four path for the drive and was empty. LT. BICKETT was four wide through the turn and was done entering the lane.
