COUNTRY MINISTER chased the pace three wide into the turn, bid three wide near the quarter pole to get nearest the leader, moved with that one into the lane then drew away the last eighth. JAXSON BE GOOD was unhurried early while off the inside, moved up through the three path on the turn, made a menacing move into the lane then could not gain further on the winner and was vanned off. BUDGET BARGAIN was along the inside through the turn and into the lane and moved up for the disant show spot. MAJIC LITE vied for the lead along the inside through mid-turn then gave way entering the lane. COULD BE MICHAEL settled off the pace while near the inside then moved up while not a threat. GOOD GRIEF was never a factor while moving three wide through the turn. CHARLIE ST GOLD was in the three or four path through the turn and remained in contention into late turn then tired. RIB SOX vied for the lead two wide into the far turn then faded. REASON TO SPEED steadily faded along the inside. MY MAN KODY stumbled badly at the start, saved ground throughout and never was a menace. RIGHT TO WAR was never involved from off the inside.
