Footnotes

FROSTING pressed the pace three wide through the turn,fanned into mid-track into the lane and lost ground to the pacesetter, did not look like a winner in mid-stretch then found best stride late and surged to the front. SILENCEONSUNDAY set the pace along the inside throughout, shook bids coming into the lane and was still in front very late then was outfinished. CORYDONMARIA chased the pace from the two or three path through the turn then finished with good energy to gain the show spot late. SUITE FAITH chased the pace from the two or three path through the turn when never far back, was well placed with an eighth to go then lacked a closing response. THAT'S THE ANSWER was reluctant to load requiring the work of several assistant starters, broke well and raced within striding distance into the lane and lacked a rally while racing evenly. WYNN'S DECISION was never a factor while in the four path into the lane. SHE HOPES TO DANCE pressed the pace two wide into the lane and faded late. PERFECT JAB was outrun while near the inside. A BENE C was outrun throughout while in the three or four path. IZZIE LONG LEGS was outrun from the three path.
