WALLSTREET CHARLIE pressed the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn then took over the lead and lost the whip inside the eighth pole then drew clear under a steady drive. STALWART TEE was bumped at the start, angled off the rail into the turn then rallied in the stretch but was not enough. SOLD OUT was bumped hard at the start, angled into the four path in the turn but couldn't sustain the bid in the stretch. LITTLE GRINDSTONE was back early, angled off the rail into the turn with a mild gain in the stretch. BANANA BLUES chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late. DINNER FOR TWO angled into the three path in the turn and moved up. FINDING TIME set the pace early from the inside, angled off the rail into the turn and gave way. CALL ME TONIGHT was through after a half. ROLLINONWALLSTREET swung widest into the lane while no threat. MAGIC BUCK broke down.
