Footnotes

CRASHING SANDSTORM unhurried early while along the inside into the turn, came off the inside into the lane when gaining momentum, caught the leader near the eighth pole and drove past. SCOTLAND PLACE raced along the inside into the turn, angled into the three path in mid-turn, continued on with good energy into the lane then finished second best. CHAFFED LIPS set the pace along the inside into the lane then weakened when challenged. POWER SHOWER was never a threat while in the two or three path. SOFT HIT along the inside into the turn, angled into the five or six path into the lane and moved up. SEA DREAMER was never a factor along the inside. OPEN BANK raced four wide through the first turn, continued four wide down the backstretch when chasing the pace then tired. MY PHILLY chased the pace from the two path into the turn then retreated. COOK'S SPECIAL raced three wide throughout and was pulled up in the lane and vanned off.
