Footnotes

DOCALOT bobbled at the start, set the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn with a long drive in the stretch and prevailed late. ASK SIDNEY tracked the pace early while on the inside into the turn with a long drive in the stretch but was outfinished. FARM BOY was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the turn and moved up in the stretch. HEBE'S EXPRESS stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened late. GENTLEMENARERARE angled into the four path in the turn while no threat. IAIN'TMADATCHA raced up close early, angled into the three path in the turn and faded late. SEA OF STEVEN was done early. SPURTABILITY had brief speed then retreated.
