Footnotes

NEW YORK GIN chased the pacesetters who were dueling through the turn, bid three wide entering the lane to draw to near even terms then was in a prolong drove to edge past and clear inside the sixteenth pole. H K JUNIOR stalked the pacesetter two wide into the turn, moved to gain a narrow advantage in mid-turn, continued on near even terms with dueling counterpart when joined by the winner into the lane, put away dueling rival inside the eighth pole but could not match strides with the winner late. NICKERS FOR CANDY set the pace into the turn while under pressure, continued on near the front-end into the lane and weakened in the final eighth. WIN DOUGH REID chased the pace into the lane while in the three path and lacked a closing response. DO DAT TUNE was never a factor while in the three path through the turn. MAJOR POINT was outrun from along the inside. DR. JASPER vied for the lead into the backstretch then dropped back entering the turn and was eased through the final eighth.
