PLAY SOLEIL chased the pace from the three path through the turn, fanned into mid-track for the drive and gained momentum inside the eighth pole and drove past late. CASTLE PRINCESS pressed the dueling leaders three wide through the turn, bid into the lane to get near the front-end then could not go with the winner, lost place spot near the sixteenth pole and regained it in the final strides. WHY IZZY WHY settled off the early pace, bid into the lane, angled to the inside, looked to be a serious threat then was outfinished by the winner and lost the place spot in the final stride. SUNRISE LILY vied for the lead two wide into the lane and yielded inside the eighth pole. ROCKIN DEE was in the three or four path through the turn and moved up while never a threat. ZIPPY MISS ISSIE chased the pace from the three or four path into the lane, came widest for the drive and tired. SAQQARAH was never a threat while near the inside. MAZIES BLING vied for the lead along the inside then gave was entering the lane. ZAVAT'S COMET was outrun from the three path.
