BLUE RYDER RED went three wide on the first turn, lagged well back in the field, advanced four then five wide on the far turn, chased in upper stretch, made a bid near the eighth-pole, battled with the runner-up in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. SHORT SALE went three wide on the first turn, settled in third position but well behind the top two, advanced three wide on the far turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, battled with the winner in the final furlong and was denied. CINCO ESTRELLA lingered well back in the field, was urged along while four wide on the far turn and just got up for the show. MABEE STORMY bumped with a rival at the start, went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced four wide on the far turn, chased into upper stretch, drifted in near the furlong marker and tired. NICKERS FOR CANDY settled while off the rail, was ridden along on the far turn and lacked the needed response. MISTER MOORELAND was hustled from the start, disputed the pace on the outside through solid fractions, moved clear midway down the backstretch, vied inside on the far turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and tired. NEW YORK GIN bumped with an opponent at the start, went four then three wide on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch, came under the whip near the half-mile pole, went three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. CHOW WAGON went three to four wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and failed to threaten. THE NEW BUCKETLIST disputed the pace on the inside, dropped back a bit midway down the backstretch, moved out entering the far turn, chased into upper stretch and capitulated. VINNIE settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn and was no factor.
