Footnotes

COOL TRICK tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the turn with a long drive in the stretch and edged past late under a steady drive. RARE COGNAC pressed the pace early, took over the lead, angled off the rail into the turn with a long drive in the stretch but was outfinished late. CRAFTY CAPE led the field early from the inside, stayed on the rail into the turn and gave way in the stretch. BRANDYWINE RUN was unhurried early, angled off the rail into the turn and moved up in the stretch. B L'S SAND SHARK was done early. GOLD GAMBLER showed little.
