Footnotes

MOONPORT was unhurried early while saving ground, continued along the inside, benefited when leaders came off the rail near the eighth pole then surged to the front late. KENNESSEY was along the inside through the turn, remained along the inside while looking for room inside the eighth pole, angled to the four path inside the sixteenth pole and finished full of run to just miss. BELL BY THE RIDGE tracked the pace along the inside, moved to the two path entering the lane to bid for the lead then was outfinished very late. STORMY GOING set the pace into the lane, was challenged for the lead with an eighth to go then yielded late. GRIZZLED ROBERT stalked the pace two wide through the turn, was well positioned into the lane then weakened. NOWHERE TO HIDE was four wide through the turn when chasing the pace, fanned widest into the lane and lacked a closing bid. MOUNTAIN JUSTICE was in the two or three path through the turn and never factored. EL ALEMAN never factored while in the three path through the turn. AL BASHA steadied entering the first turn, chased the pace from off the inside then faded through the lane. FIST OF RAGE was in the four path through the turn and was done entering the lane. GHOST IS CLEAR was outrun near the inside. DONT TELL KITTEN steadily lost ground while in the three path.
