SAILORS PASTTIME dueled early, while on the inside into the turn then shook clear in the stretch under a steady drive. SHINE OLA was unhurried early, angled into the three path in the turn and was gaining late. MY LIL' DARLIN vied for the lead early while four wide, angled into the three path in the turn and weakened late. SHERRY'S TIGER angled into the four path in the turn with some gain in the stretch. ASH dueled early while three wide, angled off the rail into the turn and faded late. LOVING ROE IS EASY pressed early from between horses, angled off the rail into the turn and gave way in the stretch. STONE RUNNER was done early. K P'S LUCKY GIRL trailed the field throughout.
