MUTAKDDIM'S CROWN settled off the pace while in the three or four path through the turn, moved into the four path for the drive, gained momentum inside the eighth pole and rushed past and cleared late. LIVERMAN chased the pace three wide through the turn, bid on the dueling leaders into the lane, gained a lead near the eighth pole, looked to be a winner inside the sixteenth pole but had no answer for the fast closing winner. ELLENBERGER PARK was along the rail through the turn, appeared to be empty in the lane then unleashed a spirited but belated bid. RUMORS EVERYWHERE pressed the pace two wide through the turn then weakened in the lane. BELLA'S FELLA bobbled at the start, hustled up to vie for the lead along the inside, continued on the front end into the lane and was empty in the drive. SCATTERFIELD chased the pace along the inside and lacked a bid. COMING ON was in the two path through the turn and came up empty in the drive. TRICK O MAN was in the two or three path through the turn and never factored. HELL SPIKE was finished after traveling a half while in the three or four path. MONARCA LEGACY trailed throughout while near the inside.
