SNICKLEBRITCHES chased the pace from the three path into the turn, bid in mid-turn, moved clear entering the lane and remained on an open lead to the end. ALBERTA'S BOOK was in the three path through the turn and was gaining in the lane. GYPSY BABY (IRE) was unhurried while along the inside, was gaining momentum into the lane, altered into the three path near the eight pole then back to the two path when rival drifted into her path then finished with good energy. HANNA FOM SAVANAH was in the two or three path through the turn then rallied belatedly. QUEEN OF ARTS was steadied at the half mile pole and again at the eight pole when in tight and still offered a mild gain. J W'S LAST DANCE set the pace along the inside into the turn then gave way. SWEET REDEEMER was four wide through the turns and into the lane and lacked a bid. SERNA'S GOLD was in the three path through the turn and was never a menace. ALYSSA'S NATIVE chased the pace from the three path and faded after a half.
