ASPIRE TO SUCCEED set the pace through the turn while under pressure from the inside, repelled challenger in the lane then was kept to the task to hold. PRAYER ANSWERED was in the two path through the turn, angled into mid-track for the drive and was closing in. BAYOU PALACE chased the pace along the rail into the lane and finished evenly. HONEST PROPHET bid from the three path through the turn then hung in the final eighth. SPLIT FINGER was in the five path into the lane and offered a belated effort. MY PAL RICHIE was in the three or four path into the lane and lacked a rally. MALIBU HARBOR vied for the lead along the inside and faded. FAIR OAK never factored while in the three path. RISKY DEPUTY chased the pace from the three path and tired. SODA JERK was well back on the turn and was pulled up and walked off.
