TAMED TROUBLE was unhurried early, gained momentum through the turn, fanned into the eight path into the lane and finished with good energy to be up in time. FINAL PITSTOP was along the inside through the turn, got through to gain a clear lead with an eight to go then could not hold safe. CHARLOTTETOWN bid three wide into the lane, loomed a serious threat then was outfinished. HIYABEN was behind a wall of rivals into the lane then moved up from mid-track. ROYAL CROWN COSMO was close up early while in the three or four path then passed tired ones late. J T 'S COPPERLINE vied for the lead between rivals then faded. CLIFF'S LONGSHOT vied for the lead along the inside then tired. WAKI DIABLO pressed the pace three wide then faded. RUNNING TAB was outrun while coming wide into the lane. UNBRIDLED ONE was through early while in the two or three path. M C IS MOVING ON turned in a dull effort.
