Footnotes

FERDIE'S GUY set the pace while under pressure, shook free entering the lane, lost whip near the eighth pole then widened thereafter. OCK MAN pressed the pace two or three wide into the lane then did not have enough while second best. TOUGH LITTLE NUT was along the inside into the lane and finished best of the rest. BRENT THE BANKER tracked the pace from along the inside then lacked a bid. STEPPIN AHEAD was in the two path through the turn and moved up. SGT MAJOR SCHLOSKY was in the four or five path into the lane and passed tired ones. TOWERING FOOL pressed the pace three wide and tired. STORMY DECEPTION was never a menace while in the three path through the turn. DOWN 'N DUSTY was along the inside and tired. CRACKER DAVE was close up when steadied and retreated through the turn. CROWNFORADAY was along the inside and dropped far back. GOLDEN LAUCHER stumbled at the start and lost rider.
