**Footnotes**

SIR DAKOTA chased the pace from the two path through the turn, bid outside the eighth pole, split rivals near the sixteenth pole, gained a quick lead then was all out to hold. CHOW WAGON was well back early from off the inside, bid from the five path into the lane and was closing in. JACKS ARE LUCKY set the pace into the lane then yielded late. CHIS MAGIC bid three wide through the turn and did not have enough. PRESIDENTIAL BALL chased the pace from the three path and weakened. FLAT OUT RICH was in the two path through the turn and leveled late. MAGIC ROCK was in the three path through the turn and moved up. SWEET LITTLE DIXIE was along the inside into the lane and improved while not a threat. EZEL never factored while off the inside. NEED MONEY DAD chased the pace into the turn and tired. DEFENSIVE FLIP tired along the inside. MOONSHINE STILL was through after a half from the four path.
