Footnotes

TIDY UP was away alertly to gain the lead from the outset, remained with a clear advantage into the turn, widened after straightening in the lane and was kept to the task to maintain the diminishing advantage. BRIAN'S PEAK was in mid-pack into the turn while near the inside, was roused in mid-turn and found best stride late. BALLACOLLA was unhurried from off the rail, bid four wide near the quarter pole and gained belatedly. EXTERIOR was void of speed while off the inside, fanned into the five path into the lane and rallied belatedly. OLD SCUDDER was in the four path into the lane and moved up. THE POTTERS HAND chased the pace from the two path into the turn then weakened in the lane. BOOM BOOM CHARLIE was never a factor along the inside. DUE EAST chased the pace into the turn from the two path then tired. GOLDEN WILDCAT chased the pace into the turn, bid three wide in mid-turn then faded through the lane. GREY T GIFT was in the three or four path into the lane and tired. BLACKJACK FRANK trailed throughout from near the inside.
